Sub: Umpiring Seminar and Exam for **Retired Cricketers (Male/Female)**

Dear Sirs,

BCCI is committed to the welfare of retired cricketers who have contributed immensely to the game. BCCI will be inducting retired cricketers (male/female) who are keen on umpiring and available full time to officiate in BCCI matches. They will be exempted from Umpires Level - 1 course and can directly participate in Umpires Level - 2 Course and examinations thereafter.

You are therefore requested to send maximum of four names of retired cricketers which meet below criteria before **31<sup>st</sup> December 2022**. Finer details and information about logistics will be shared in due course.

1. Should have played a minimum of 10 BCCI matches (U16, U19, U23/25 and First Class)
2. Players belonging to Northeast member associations (Sikkim, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Nagaland, Manipur and Mizoram), should have played a minimum of five BCCI matches (U16, U19, U23/25 and First Class).
3. Maximum age limit for appearing in this exam is 45 years as of **1<sup>st</sup> September 2022**.

Below is the flowchart for the seminar.

- A three-day seminar will be conducted by the BCCI International Panel Umpires and Umpire Committee Members in Ahmedabad in January on below subjects.
  1. BCCI Playing Conditions 2022 - 23 (**No MCC Laws**)
  2. Basic Calculations on over rate and interruptions.
  3. Practical and On-field skills



- Level 2 exam will be conducted after four months in Ahmedabad.
